Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of a direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 not to unnecessarily harass the petitioners and their son and family members by calling them to the police station again and again.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had withdrawn the previous petition faced with the query of the Court that there is no specific instances regarding the prayer made in the petition which are discernible from the petition. Present petition has been filed with better particulars and a reference to the specific dates and mobile phone numbers from which the petitioners have been receiving calls to attend the police station have been made in para Nos.29 and 30, to which the attention of the Court has been drawn.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Mavpreet Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to

respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decided their representation dated 29.06.2022 (Annexure P-1).

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners and without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 29.06.2022 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law.
