At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners restricts his prayer for deciding the representation/legal notice dated 02.01.2020 (Annexure P-3).

He would submit that the petitioners would be satisfied if the said representation is decided by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service. She raises no objection to the restricted prayer for consideration and decision on the justice demand notice, within some stipulated time.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion either on the merits of the claim raised in the petition or in the representation/legal notice on behalf of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation/legal notice dated 02.01.2020 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of

a certified copy of this order.

Needless to observe that in case, after the decision, petitioners are found entitled for any benefits, the same be paid to them within a period of four weeks thereafter, as per law.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
