This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents No. 2 and 3 to issue new Arms License to the petitioner, as the file No. 241-LCD/29.7.2020 is pending with the office of respondent No.2 since last more than two hand a half years despite the fact that the same has been cleared by the Local Area Police, Offices of DSP and SP.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents pass a speaking order on representation dated 16.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) within a time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner dated

16.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
