The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of direction to the respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, which according to the petitioner is in danger at the hands of respondents No.3 and 4.

After the notice of motion was issued, the respondent-State has filed reply dated 02.02.2022 wherein, it has been mentioned that respondent No.4 has already been transferred from Police Station Division No.6, District Ludhiana and the investigation has been entrusted to ASI Deep Chand.

Learned State counsel during the course of virtual hearing submits that in case hereinafter, the petitioner apprehends any threat perception to his life and liberty, he is free to approach the competent authority by raising the said grievance and in case, any representation is

received from the petitioner, an appropriate order on the same will be

passed in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the reply filed by the respondent-State as well as the statement made by the learned State counsel, the petitioner does not press the present petition any further and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.

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As prayed for, the present application is disposed of having been not pressed.
