The petitioners had filed a revision petition seeking transfer of proceedings for appointment of village Lambardar from District Collector, Moga to some other district. The said petition has been dismissed vide impugned order dated 20.07.2022 on the ground that the apprehension that the private respondent herein would influence the appointment through his political links has not been substantiated.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent No. 4 is very close to the sitting MLA from Dharamkot and this is evident from various posters and photographs.

Assuming that respondent No. 4 is very close to the sitting MLA that by itself does not establish that the sitting MLA would approach the Collector in the matter of appointment of village Lambardar. The same, in any case, does not lead to the inference that the Collector will be influenced by such an approach. Thus, the impugned order does not deserve to be interfered with.

The writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
