The petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of order and direction to the respondents No.1, 2 & 3 to implement/enforce the mandatory Rule 17A of The Industrial Employment (Standing Orders), Punjab Rules, 1949 incorporated by the Haryana Government Labour Department vide Notification No.11/4/2012-4 Lab, dated 06.08.2013 and to implement the order dated 29.11.2021 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.2 by ensuring the respective jobs/employment of the petitioners in respondent No.4 with their all legitimate outstanding dues etc.; along with certain other prayers.

Undisputedly the dispute relates to the service conditions of the workman, as claimed by the petitioners. The said grievance of the petitioners regarding prejudicial terms and conditions being adopted by the employer, has to be raised before the specified authority prescribed under the Industrial Disputes Act. Therefore, at this stage, this court does not find it appropriate to interfere in the matter, in any manner, whatsoever.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy available to them, in accordance with law.
