1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 21.02.2019, in CWP-4663-2019, wherein the respondent had been directed to consider and decide the representation submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order, as expeditiously as possible.

2. On 06.03.2020, while issuing notice for 21.07.2020, compliance report was called for.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, refers to affidavit filed by the respondent along with order Annexure R/1 dated 30.10.2020, passed on representation dated 06.03.2019, submitted by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but liberty be granted to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 30.10.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. Learned DAG also contends that in view of order Annexure R/1 dated 30.10.2020, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondent.

5. I have considered the submission of learned counsel.

6. Admittedly, order Annexure R/1 dated 30.10.2020, has been passed by the respondent, in compliance of order dated 21.02.2019, in CWP-4663-2019 and the representation submitted by the petitioner has been rejected.

7. Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 30.10.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
