HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed for quashing the impugned orders dated 03.04.2018 and 03.07.2018, being Annexures P-5 and P-8, respectively, vide which the grant of ACPs, for which the petitioner is entitled for in respect of the services rendered by him, have been rejected by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the claim, as being raised by the petitioner in the present petition, is being declined by the respondents on the basis that the ACRs of the petitioner were not up to the mark, and therefore, the said claim is not admissible to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that keeping

in view the documents supplied to the petitioner under the R.T.I., the

Chairman of the respondent-Department has already upgraded all the concerned ACRs of the petitioner to 'Good', which makes him entitled for the grant of the benefit of ACPs.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner approaches the respondent-Department along with the said order by filing an appropriate representation, the same will be considered and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation and in case the petitioner is found entitled for the grant of any amount, the same will also be released in his favour within a period of next four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the submissions made on behalf of learned counsel for the respondents, as recorded hereinbefore, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further at this stage with the liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
