This common order shall dispose of the above-mentioned two criminal miscellaneous petitions as both the cases arise out of the same FIR.

By way of CRM-M-41535-2021, the petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 02.09.2021 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib granting anticipatory bail to respondent Nos.2 and 3 in case FIR No.181 dated 15.08.2021 under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860
