Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.11 dated 30.01.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur along with consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners candidly submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail their alternative remedies as available to them under the law. He has submitted that the petitioners are residing in Canada and since the date of lodging of the FIR, the investigating agencies are not proceeding with the investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that as the petitioners have not joined investigation, the investigation is pending.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. The investigating agencies are directed to expedite the investigation and conclude the same in accordance with the law.
