VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.26 dated 24.02.2008, registered under Sections 323, 341, 379, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the parties have pointed out that apart from respondent No.2, one Jagtar is also an injured/victim and the said Jagtar had died leaving behind his mother as the legal representative, who has not been made as party in the petition and no compromise has been effected with the said legal representative of said Jagtar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after making all the necessary persons as party in the petition and after entering into compromise with all of them, including the legal representative of said Jagtar.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
