1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 07.08.2020, in CWP-11431-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 07.08.2020 reveals that CWP-11431-2020 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the claim as made in representation dated 30.03.2019, in accordance with law, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of Annexure R-1, dated 30.07.2021, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same while granting liberty to the petitioner challenge order Annexure R-1 dated 30.07.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
