[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 01.06.2022, in CWP No.12547 of 2022 in case titled as '**Kavita versus State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.12547 of 2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the representation filed by the petitioner and pass an order, in respect thereto in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case.

[4] However, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of speaking order dated 30.08.2020 passed by the respondent, rejecting the claim of the petitioner, as contained in the representation on account of his having secured lesser marks than the last selected candidate. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the

petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to challenge order dated 30.08.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
