This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to register the petitioner firm for the purpose of custom milling of paddy. It is submitted that his firm has not been registered so far on account of not possessing the requisite land as specified under the policy.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that a fresh policy for the kharif season 2022-23 has been formulated and he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to apply afresh under the new policy. In case his grievance is still not redressed, he is at liberty to approach this Court again.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
