This second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been moved by the petitioners-**Sandeep Kumar** and **Monika Rani** for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.1488 dated 10.12.2019 under Sections 406 of 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 01.06.2022, balance amount of Rs.1,20,000/- has already been paid by the petitioners in favour of respondent No.2 – complainant through Chaudhary Finance Company. He further submits that both the petitioners have already joined investigation.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for respondent No.2 – complainant submits that at present nothing is due from the petitioners.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Parvinder Singh submits that in compliance of order dated 16.12.2020 and subsequent orders dated 15.03.2021, 28.09.2021, 15.03.2022, 11.05.2022 and 01.06.2022, petitioners have already joined investigation and are not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

In view of above, order dated 16.12.2020 granting interim bail to petitioners, is made absolute. Petitioners shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
