Main case

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.60 dated 24.05.2018, registered for offences under Sections 498-A, 406, 420, 376-B, 377 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short “IPC”), however, later on Sections 376-B, 377 and 506, IPC were deleted and Section 34, IPC was added, at Women Police Station, Sector-51, Gurugram.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR is an outcome of a matrimonial dispute and the petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant, has returned to India and has joined the investigation.

The fact regarding the joining of investigation has been affirmed by the State counsel upon instructions received from L/ASI, Chanderkanta and he has submitted that a supplementary challan has been presented.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the FIR, present petition is allowed.

Order dated 20.04.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
