Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.330 dated 25.08.2020, under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 and 34 of IPC (as Section 354, 376, 511 IPC were deleted by police later on from FIR), registered at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar.

By virtue of the order dated 17.02.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Asha Rani has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required

for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 17.02.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
