The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner has invoked the extraordinary jurisdiction of the High Court with the following prayers:-

“Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of writ of Mandamus to the respondent No. 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members as well as the minor children of the deceased Sandeep Kaur from the hands of the official as well as private respondents No. 4 to 7, so that they may not become a victim of subjugation and persecution inflicted upon them by the accused persons and deliberate inaction and riling of State Police Mechanism:

AND

Further issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of writ of Mandamus to the respondent No. 2 to hand over the investigation of case FIR No. 122, dated 11.10.2020 under Section 302, 120-B, 34 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran to some independent investigating agency or it may be directed that the investigation of the aforesaid case be supervised by some senior IPS Rank Police Officer

AND

Further issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of writ of Mandamus to

the respondent No. 2 and 3 to submit the status report of the case FIR No. 122, dated 11.10,2020 under Section 302, 120 B, 34 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran

AND/OR

For issuance of any other appropriate order or directions, which this Hon'ble court may deem fit and proper in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case.”

The petitioner alleges that his daughter has been killed by respondent No.4 at the instigation of the remaining respondents.

Sh. H.S. Sullar, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has entered appearance on behalf of the State of Punjab and submits that respondent No.4 has been arrested and on the conclusion of the investigation, the final report has been filed in the Court.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate application before the trial Court.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
