In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner had missed the chance to appear in the scrutiny of the documents due to her ill health which scrutiny was held on 08.08.2022 and hence, the respondents be directed to scrutinize the documents of the petitioner and allow her to continue with the selection process.

While issuing notice of motion on 23.08.2022, the petitioner was allowed to appear in the interview provisionally after scrutinizing of the documents.

Though, no reply has been filed by the respondents so far but learned State counsel submits that keeping in view the provisional result of the petitioner, the petitioner has secured 109 marks in the category in which she is competing whereas, the last selected candidate in the said category in

the waiting list has secured 125 marks hence, the petitioner is not eligible to be considered for further selection.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been granted marks for experience and in case marks for experience has been counted, the petitioner will secure same marks as the last candidate in the waiting list.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

In the present petition, the only prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to allow her to appear for scrutiny of documents and to continue with the selection process. By an interim order, the petitioner has already participated in the entire selection process and keeping in view the provisional result of the petitioner, she has not been able to secure the marks as secured by the last selected candidate in the category in which she is competing or marks secured by the last candidate in the waiting list hence, the petitioner cannot be allowed to continue with the selection process any further and the prayer of the petitioner has already been rendered academic.

With regard to the prayer of the petitioner for the grant of marks for experience, in case the petitioner has any grievance, she can approach the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation or by availing any other remedy as deemed fit by the petitioner.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioner requests for supplying her copy of any document, keeping in view the settled principle of law, respondent-Commission is directed to furnish the copy of the

documents to the petitioner so that she can avail an appropriate remedy for the redressal of her grievance.

Present petition stands disposed of in above terms.
