While issuing notice of motion, the following order was
passed:-

“Apprehending his arrest in FIR No.57 dated 05.04.2022 for offences punishable under Section 407 IPC, 1860 (Section 411 of IPC was added later on) registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana, the petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the alleged embezzled property already stands recovered. Thus, it will not be a case where custodial interrogation of the petitioner will be required.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Mr. Mohinder Singh Joshi, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. As and when called, the petitioner shall join the investigation. He shall abide by the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

To come up on 10.11.2022.”

Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sahib Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation. Apart from that, the petitioner has been booked for offence punishable under Sections 407 and 411 of IPC and the alleged embezzled property stands recovered.

In view of the aforesaid facts, the interim order dated 23.08.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
