RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

This petition has been filed by the petitioner alleging that the respondents have not decided his application seeking grant of permit under the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, in spite of the directions issued by this Court vide order dated 16.05.2017 passed in CWP No. 9491 of 2017 filed by the petitioner, whereby the petition was disposed of with the following directions :

“Without entering into the further controversy, let the petitioner apply on appropriate form under the Stage Carriage Scheme of 2016 within a period of 15 days. In case any application is filed in proper format, it is directed that it will be considered by the State Transport Authority, Haryana, in accordance with law within a period of two months thereafter.”

On the previous date of hearing, we had asked learned Additional Advocate General, appearing on behalf of the State of Haryana, to seek instructions, and inform this Court about the status of the petitioner’s application.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions, submits that application of the petitioner is pending with the authorities and the same shall be decided within a period of two weeks in accordance with law and the directions issued by this Court vide order dated 16.05.2017 passed in CWP No. 9491 of 2017.

In view of the aforesaid statement of learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, which is taken on record, the petition is disposed of in terms thereof.
