After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to move an application for grant of regular bail.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn. In case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within 10 days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within one week from filing of such application while duly taking into account the fact that the recovered contraband would fall within the category of 'non-commercial' quantity.
