The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 02.11.2017 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Additional District Judge, Family Court, Bhiwani while sitting in the Daily Lok Adalat. The operative part of the said order reads thus:

“Efforts to reunite the parties made. Thereafter compromise of the matter in dispute between the parties has today been effected in the Daily Lok Adalat. Joint statement of both the parties has been recorded in this regard. The petitioners have, due to the reason of compromise of the matter in dispute, desired for withdrawal of the present petition. In view of the statement so got recorded by both the parties, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn being compromised in the Daily Lok Adalat. The parties shall remain bound by their statement today made before the Daily Lok Adalat. File be consigned to record room.”

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner inter alia contends that even though the aforesaid order had been passed on the strength of a settlement arrived at between the parties and their statements were also recorded, however, there were certain disputes in the interregnum in relations to the terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties.

Be that as it may, the same does not entitle the petitioner to raise a challenge to the award. The present petition is accordingly withdrawn. The petitioner would be at liberty to raise an appropriate challenge to the consequential proceedings that may have been initiated in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
