The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.41 dated 12.05.2022 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149, 307 IPC registered at Police Station Fattu Dyinga, District Kapurthala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 24.08.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel has filed a short reply dated 06.12.2022 in the Court today. The same is taken on record. He submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 24.08.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 24.08.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
