CRM-M-37755-2022

This is the second petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in Sessions case bearing No.SC/177/2018 titled as State Versus Maninder Singh and others, pending in the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar (Mohali) in FIR No.60 dated 23.03.2018, registered for offences under Sections 376, 328, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

By referring to orders dated 17.05.2018 and 13.08.2018, Annexures P-4 and P-5, respectively, counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M-21236-2018. He submits that due to reasons beyond control of the petitioner, he could not appear before the Trial Court on 13.07.2022, when the bail/surety bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued for his arrest. He submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the Trial Court and join the proceedings.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. P.S.Grewal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He submits that the next date before the Trial Court is 17.09.2022.

Heard counsel for the parties.

Let the petitioner surrender before the Trial Court on or before 17.09.2022. In case, he does so and files a petition seeking grant of regular bail, the Trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide it on the day it is filed provided that the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court in the pre-lunch session.

Petition is disposed of.
