The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.142 dated 12.09.2021 registered under Sections 406/420 IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that a settlement has been effected between the parties. In terms of the said settlement, the entire payment due to the complainant has been made by the petitioners i.e. Balwinder Kaur in the present petition and Sukhvir Singh Thapar in CRM-M-43006-2021 in the connected petition.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.10.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Neela Ram admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.10.2021 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
