Petitioner-Ranjit Singh is seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.147 dated 3.11.2017, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 20, District Panchkula.

On 5th September, 2019, the following order was passed:

"Today, Mr. Satish Singla, Advocate, appears for the complainant and submits that though the matter has in fact been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant, but the terms of the compromise are still to be complied with, inasmuch as some amount is still due from the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on interim bail upon his furnishing adequate surety and bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court, till the next date of hearing before this court, with the complainant to file an affidavit as to whether the terms of the compromise have been complied with or not.

Adjourned to 17.09.2019.

The matter was referred to Mediation. The petitioner till date is on interim bail.

As per the Mediation report, the parties have amicably settled the matter.

There are no allegations that the interim bail was misused, the petitioner is granted regular bail on the basis of surety bond already furnished.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
