SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)

On the very outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that he will not press for the first prayer made in the petition i.e. issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3, to conduct fair, independent, transparent inquiry/investigation against respondents No.4 to 7 for attacking and inflicting grievous injuries upon the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioner further states that for said part of the prayer, he will adopt some other method under the law by approaching the concerned Court/forum.

Counsel for the petitioner further submits that he restricts his prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, for which already there is a representation/application addressed to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, wherein, the petitioners (applicants therein) have also asked for protection for life and liberty.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. J.S. Arora, DAG, Punjab, who

is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 (State). Copy of the petitioner has already been supplied to the learned State counsel by the counsel for the petitioners.

After hearing counsel for the parties and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the view that once representation *qua* the threat to the life and liberty, has already been moved by the petitioners on 02.07.2022 (P-1), having been addressed to respondent No.2, must be looked into and be examined only to the extent of threat perception, if any, to the life and liberty of the petitioners, in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
