Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.232 dated 21.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 (2) (N) of IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012, Section 9 of Child Marriage Act and Sections 3 (2) (v) of The Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (initially, FIR was registered under Sections 363/366-A of IPC and Sections 3(2) (v) of SC/ST Act, 1989), registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

The petitioner is behind the bars since 28.07.2022.

Learned State counsel, at the very outset, has submitted that out of 23 prosecution witnesses, 20 witnesses have already been examined and the rest of 03 have been summoned by the trial Court for today itself.

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He submits that the trial is at the fag end and, thus, the present petition for grant of bail to the petitioner be declined.

In view of the submissions made by the learned State counsel and after perusing the record, this Court does not find it appropriate to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage. However, as the trial has reached its final stage, the trial Court is requested to conclude the trial, expeditiously.

Disposed of with the above observations.
