Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that the petitioner is part of NCC Office also and hence he be treated separately as compared to other teachers while effecting transfer for the sessions 2022-23, which benefit is not being given to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by filing a representation dated 15.0.7.2022 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 15.0.7.2022 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 15.0.7.2022 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 15.0.7.2022 (Annexure P-2) within a period of ten days from the receipt of copy of this order.
