[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 20.05.2022 in CWP No.10949 of 2022 in case titled as Anil Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.10949 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondents therein to decide representation dated 09.03.2022 filed by the petitioner and to pass an administrative order, in accordance with law.

[3] Learned DAG has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Ashok Kumar, the then Civil Surgeon, Narnaul dated 14.11.2022 along with speaking order, Annexure R/1 dated 31.08.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 09.03.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 31.08.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in

accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
