At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 22.08.2022 (Annexure P-3) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection of their life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon the judgment titled as 'Jashanpreet Kaur and another versus State of Punjab and others' reported as 2019 (4) RCR (Civil) 183 and orders passed by this Court in CRWP No.973 of 2022 titled as 'Gaurav and another versus State of Haryana and others'; CRWP No.4572 of 2022 titled as 'Neelam and another versus State of Punjab and others' and CRWP No.4725 of 2021 titled as 'Seema Kaur and another versus State of Punjab and others', to contend that petitioner No.2 has a right to get protection of life and liberty even if she is minor.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter and in particular the legality of the alleged relationship, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, District SAS Nagar to forthwith consider the aforesaid representation dated 22.08.2022 (Annexure P-3) made on behalf of the petitioners and thereafter, take appropriate action on the same as is deemed fit in accordance with law to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to validate the alleged relationship between the petitioners or protect them from legal action for violation, if any, committed by them.
