In view of the oral agreed statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as learned counsel for the Insurance Company, both the parties have compromised for a sum of Rs.3,90,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh Ninety Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, to be paid to the appellant as full and final settlement of their claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque/draft in the sum of Rs.3,90,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh Ninety Thousand Only) in favour of the appellant No.1 (Kirandeep Kaur), with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from the receipt of the copy of this order. The said amount shall be distributed among the appellants in equal share. In case appellant No.2 is minor his share be deposited in a nationalized

bank in the form of FDR to be realised by the said appellant on his

attaining the age of majority.

In case the amount is not deposited within the prescribed period, the appellants shall be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum on their respective share from the date of this order till the date of realisation.

The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the learned counsel for appellants as a receipt on record.

Appeal stands disposed of.
