Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.127 dated 2.8.2021 registered under Sections 363, 366-A IPC (Section 10 of the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006 and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012 added lateron) at Police Station Kalka, District Panchkula.

By virtue of the order dated 4.10.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.
