Pursuant to order dated 25.08.2022, report has been received
wherein it has been reported that:-

“xx xx xx

2. It is respectfully submitted that the after perusal of the
statement of the complainants, injured as well as
accused, the pointwise requisite report of the
undersigned is as under:-

1.	The number of persons arrayed as accused in the complaint.	There is only one accused namely Sunny the complaint arrayed in the complaint who has appeared and suffered his statement before the court.
2.	Whether any accused is proclaimed offender?	No
3.	Whether the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence?	Yes

4.	Whether the accused persons are involved in any other case or not?	The accused is involved in another complaint u/s NACT 5467/2017 titled M/s. Tauranga Traders Vs Sunny. Collective compromise to the tune of Rs. 1,90,000/- has been effected in present complaint i.e. NACT/4349-2016 and NACT/5467/2017.
5.	The trial court is also directed to record the statement of Investigating Officer as to how many victims/complainants are there in the complaint.	There is only one complainant namely M/s. Tauranga Traders through its Proprietor Nishant Thakur arrayed in the complaint who has appeared and suffered his statement before the court. Since it is a private complaint, so, there is no I.O. in the present case.”

2. In terms of the report received from the concerned quarter, the offence of the petitioner stands compounded by the complainant.

3. Consequently, the present revision petition is allowed.

4. Since the main case has been decided, pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed off.
