MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.182 dated 26.06.2021 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar, who apprehends her arrest at the hands of Police.

On 04.10.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel has argued that the alleged amount of Rs.6,50,000/- was paid by the complainant in the year 2019 pursuant to the promise made by co-accused Roshan Lal for providing job, but the FIR has been lodged after a long delay. According to him, the petitioner has been falsely implicated being employee of Roshan Lal and the amount was infact paid to co-accused Roshal Lal and Aman Kumar, who have been arrested. He states that the petitioner is willing to join the investigation, therefore, she deserves the concession of anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion for 31.01.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the

satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated herself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Suresh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 04.10.2021 is made absolute.
