The petitioner in the instant petition has sought anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure arising out of FIR No.146 dated 17.09.2021, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City 1 Mansa, District Mansa.

It is also apparent from the record that Section 29 of the NDPS Act, was added later on, at Police Station City 1 Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no recovery has been effected from the possession of the petitioner and whatever recovery of 15 grams of heroin, has been effected, is from the other co-accused namely Ravi Kumar @ Mona and Khushi.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and neither any

recovery was effected with regard to the contraband nor any further custodial interrogation is required.

In the light of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
