HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.77 dated 18.03.2020, registered under Sections 120-B,419,420,467,468,470 and 471 of the IPC at Police Station Chhainsa, District Faridabad.

As per the allegations in the FIR, complainant Malo Bai was owner in possession of land measuring 17 marlas. It is alleged that one Banso Devi impersonated herself as Malo Bai and she in connivance with the petitioner and other co-accused sold the land to one Suman by virtue of sale deed No.344 dated 14.06.2018. The petitioner is alleged to be the attesting witness of the said sale deed. He was arrested on 20.08.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the investigation in the case is complete. Charges have been framed and the case is pending for prosecution evidence. The main accused Banso Devi has been granted the concession of regular bail by the Court of learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Faridabad vide order dated 12.05.2022. The other co-accused namely Mahender Singh has also been granted the concession of

bail by the Court of learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Faridabad, vide order dated 10.05.2021.

Considering the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted regular bail; investigation in the case is complete and that the petitioner is in custody since 20.08.2021, and the trial of the case may take long time, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

This criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner-Harmesh is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
