Petitioner, an SC candidate, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing impugned Note/ order dated 27.07.2022 (Annexure P-10), allegedly without assigning any valid reason, to the effect that one post of SC category has remained vacant due to non-availability of suitable candidates.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that *quahis* grievance, petitioner has already moved a representation dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-11) but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that competent authority shall take decision either way, on the representation dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-11), in due course.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also agrees that let a final decision be taken, by the competent authority on the representation dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-11).

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-11) and take a decision, giving reasons thereof, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 30 days from today.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
