1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.24 dated 28.01.2020 at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala, under Section 174-A IPC, which was lodged pursuant to petitioner having been declared a 'proclaimed offender' in respect of a complaint filed against him under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.
2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 07.10.2021, this Court while releasing the petitioner on interim bail had directed him to put in appearance before the trial Court.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has informed that pursuant to interim directions, the petitioner surrendered before the trial Court and is regularly appearing before the same.

4. The aforesaid factual position as regards appearance of the petitioner is not disputed by the learned State counsel.
5. Keeping in view the above stated position, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 07.10.2021 are hereby made absolute.
6. Needless to mention, the trial Court would be at liberty to impose any condition upon the petitioner so as to ensure his regular appearance during the proceedings of trial.
