1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 29.01.2019 in CRM-M-4198 of 2019 in case titled as "Gurdeep Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others".

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 29.01.2019 reveals that CRM-M-4198 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the Deputy Commissioner, Gurdaspur to look into the grievance of the petitioner as raised in the application dated 06.12.2018 (Annexure P-3).

3. Reply has been filed along with Annexures R-1 to R-5. Learned AAG, Punjab states that order, Annexure P-1, has been complied with by deciding the representation and not finding any merit in the same, on the basis of reports, Annexure R-2 and R-3, besides record Annexures R-4 and R-5 and that in the circumstances, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the

stand of the respondents, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition.

5. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
