HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the present petition is pending for the last more than four years, but no reply has been filed by the respondents till date. The grievance of the petitioner is that the certificate of Haryana Teachers Eligibility Test issued to the petitioner dated 31.01.2017, is showing its validity upto 01.12.2016, which date is even prior to the issuance date of the said certificate, whereas as per the policy, the test once cleared, will remain valid for a period of five years.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the certificate dated 31.01.2017 (Annexure P-3) needs to be corrected by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the grievance of the petitioner will be addressed by the Board of School Education, Haryana, within a period of eight weeks on receipt of the copy of this order and in case, the grievance of the petitioner is found to be valid, the

same will be redressed in accordance with law by passing appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
