 On request, the instant matter is taken up in Bi-monthly Lok Adalat, accordingly discussed.

 As per statements of the learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- (Three Lakhs and Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim.

 Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed cheque for Rs.3,50,000/- (Three Lakhs and Fifty Thousand Only) in the name of appellant No.1-Neelam with the office of Lok Adalat of the High Court within five weeks from today, in compliance of the order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of Lok Adalat.

 Copy of this order be supplied/sent to counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
