The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the award dated 18.03.2015 (Annexure P-9) passed by respondent No.1, whereby the reference made under Section 10(1) (c) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 at the instance of the petitioner, has been declined and the termination order dated 11.10.2007 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2 has been upheld; along with certain other prayers.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today. Same was the situation on some of the previous dates as well. Even the counsel representing the petitioner earlier had pleaded no instructions in the matter. Hence, it is clear that the petitioner does not intend to pursue the present petition.
