Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 does not press her claim with regard to the family pension keeping in view the facts and circumstances, which have come on record so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that petitioner No.2, who was born out of the wedlock between the petitioner No.1 namely, Saroj Bala and deceased Telu Ram is entitled for the grant of orphan pension.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that no such claim has ever been raised by the petitioners and in case, the petitioner No.2 files any representation claiming the said benefit, appropriate order on the same

will be passed in accordance with law within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that with regard to the ex-gratia, the same will also be presented before the competent authority of bank for its consideration.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Bank submits that in case, any such claim is raised by the petitioner by way of filing a representation, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statements made by learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioners subsists in the present writ petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
