JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

These three writ petitions have been filed seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of an order dated 17.05.2016 whereby the names of the petitioners have not been reflected correctly in the seniority list prepared.

Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that a fresh tentative seniority list has been prepared where the names of the petitioners have been correctly recorded and, therefore, at the present moment, the petitioners would not press the present writ petitions. It is submitted that in case the seniority list is recast at any subsequent stage and there is a deviation therein, the petitioners may be given liberty to challenge that afresh.

The present writ petitions are accordingly disposed of as infructuous in view of the fact that the grievance of the petitioners stand redressed at the present moment and nothing survives for consideration therein. However, liberty is given to the petitioners to challenge should there be any change in the final seniority list, detrimental to the petitioners.
