This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0032 dated 21.04.2016, registered under Sections 363, 366(A) of the IPC (Section 376 IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012 added later on) at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein praying for regular bail would contend that there are material discrepancies in the statement of the victim-prosecutrix. However, he would very fairly submit that after the entire evidence was concluded, the matter stands finally argued and there is no decision that is forthcoming.

Learned State counsel would oppose the grant of regular bail to the petitioner on the ground that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined

the matter has been argued and the same is now reserved for judgment.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the entire evidence having concluded and arguments having been addressed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition by giving a direction to the trial Court that in case, judgment has not been delivered in the case till date, let the judgment come forth within the period of two weeks from today.
