This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., has been filed for quashing the FIR No.130 dated 20.09.2007 under Section 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC (subsequently added 325 IPC) and Section 28 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Radaur, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 08.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) effected between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and that he would not press the instant petition at this stage. He further seeks an indulgence for issuance of a direction that in the event the petitioner's surrendering before the trial Court, his application for bail may be decided expeditiously.

Needless to mention that, in the event of the petitioner's surrendering before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today, his application for bail, if any, be decided expeditiously and preferably

within a period of 05 working days.

Petition is accordingly disposed of.
