Petitioners are praying for direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide protection to their life and liberty from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 9.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 got married with respondent No.4 but they are having strained relations and now petitioner No.1 has started living with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 9 who are now extending threats to the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that as the petitioners are apprehending threat from the side of the aforesaid private respondent, they gave representation dated 16.8.2022 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action on the basis of the said representation. Counsel for the petitioners further submitted that he will be satisfied if necessary action is taken by the authorities on the basis of the

aforesaid representation.

Mr. C.L.Pawar, Addl. AG, Punjab appearing for the official respondents submits that in case any such representation is pending, the concerned authority will look into the matter and take action in accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to consider representation dated 16.8.2022 (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law in case there is any threat perception to the petitioners.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 9 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
