Present third bail application has been filed under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail pending trial in case bearing FIR No. 127 dated 07.06.2019 registered under Sections 302 and 201 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.
